

**Bellevue School District
Immunization Requirements for 2012-2013**

PLEASE COMPLETE AND RETURN THE ATTACHED FORM WITH YOUR CHILD'S REGISTRATION.

Washington State Law RCW 28A.210.060 through RCW 28A210.170 requires presentation of proof of immunization. This must be in your child's file prior to the first day of school for 2012-2013.

Please transfer your child's records to the official Washington State Certificate of Immunization that is in your registration packet. Sign and date where indicated. Use the chart below to make sure you meet Washington requirements.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Hepatitis B	3 doses (Time intervals are mandatory) K-12	Dose 2 – can be given at least 4 weeks (24 days) after first dose. Dose 3* - Must be given at least 2 months after 2 nd dose and 16 weeks (4 months) after dose one. *Must be given at or after 6 months of age! Check dates for meeting this requirement.
<input type="checkbox"/>	DTaP/DTP/DT/TD	5 doses* (Time intervals are mandatory) K-12	*4 DOSES - If dose 4 given after 4 th birthday, 4 doses are required. If only one dose given before 1 st birthday 4 doses are required – 4 th dose given after age 4. *3 DOSES - If first dose DTaP/DT is given after 1 st birthday, 3 doses required.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Tdap	Middle/High School (6th-11th grade)*	*1 dose Tdap required for 6th-11th grade.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Polio	4 doses or 3 doses K-12	If all shots are given before the 4 th birthday or If last dose is given on or after 4 th birthday Not required for students 18 years of age or older
<input type="checkbox"/>	MMR	2 doses K-12	1 st dose must be given <u>on or after the 1st birthday</u> (4 day grace applies). 2 nd dose must be given at least 28 days after the 1 st dose (4 day grace does NOT apply). Blood test showing immunity acceptable.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Varicella	2 doses (K-3rd grade) 1 dose (4th, 5th, 6th grade)	Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd grades – must be given on or after the 1 st birthday (4 day grace applies). Parent-reported history of disease NOT acceptable. 4th, 5th, 6th grades – must be given on or after the 1 st birthday (4 day grace applies). Parent-reported history of disease is acceptable.

If your child needs additional immunizations, it is your responsibility to take care of this **prior to the first day of school. Contact your health care provider with questions on missing immunizations.**

If you are transferring from another school that is not in the Bellevue School District, it is your responsibility to fill out the form in your child's registration packet with the required dates. Please do not ask us to request an immunization record from your child's previous school if records were not sent from former school.

Office staff and nurses do their best to verify that immunizations meet state requirements at the time of registration, but occasionally something is missed. If the school nurse sends you a notice or leaves a telephone message about a missing or incomplete immunization form, please respond promptly to avoid **exclusion from school**. Thank you!
