POLICY

- 1.0 Homework is an extension of classroom learning activities. Assignments should increase in complexity with the maturity of the students and should be adjusted to meet their needs, abilities and interests.
- 2.0 The purposes of homework are to improve the learning process, to aid in the mastery of skills and to stimulate interest on the part of the students. Homework should never be assigned as a disciplinary measure.
- 3.0 Homework assignments should not require the use of reference materials not readily available in most homes, school libraries or public libraries. The use of reference materials should be required only after students have had instruction in the use of them.
- 4.0 Teachers should give clear and specific information for each assignment so that the requirements and expectations are clearly understood by the student and so that additional instruction by parents is not expected or required.
