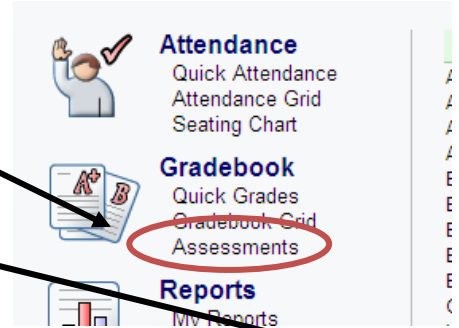


Curriculum Web using new Global Scholar

1. Rationale for moving curriculum – much the same as in previous years
 - a. Navigation and content the same
 - b. Some items hidden from parents and students, some not
 - c. Uses the web but takes teacher directly to their courses & curriculum






2. How to access the Curriculum Web
 - a. Open Gradebook – log in as usual
 - b. Under **Gradebook**, click on **Assessments**
 - c. Once in the Curriculum Web, click on **Curriculum**



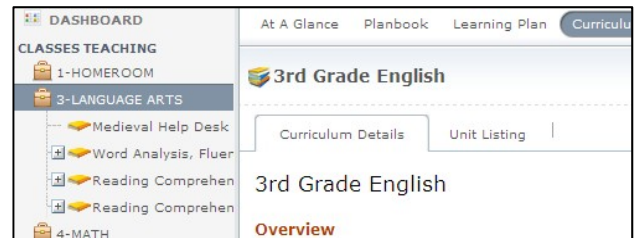
3. Tour of screen
 - a. Left navigation pane
 - i. Teacher classes listed. Click on titles to move between classes.
 - ii. Resize width of left pane or hover over text to see entire title.
 - iii. Use + and – to spill contents revealing units, lessons, etc.



- iv. Icons for parts:

Course -  (briefcase)	Activities -  (monitor)
Unit -  (closed book)	Assessments -  (clipboard)
Lessons -  (opened book)	

- b. Center Content Pane
 - i. Curriculum Details repeats information from left navigation pane.
 - ii. Click on a Course on left navigation pane



1. **Curriculum Details:** shows Overview, resources, etc.
 2. **Unit Listing:** shows units, order and duration
- iii. Click on a **Unit**
 1. **Unit Details:** shows Overview, Standards, Resources
 2. **Lessons/Activities:** shows Unit lessons, order and duration
 - iv. Click on a **Lesson**
 1. **Lesson Details** – shows overview, standards, resources (teacher & parent, and can add additional for you only)
 2. **Lessons/Activities:** shows lessons & activities within the primary lesson
 - v. Click on an **Activity**
 1. **Details:** information and resources
 - vi. Click on an **Assessment**
 1. **Preview:** shows questions
 2. **Details:** information and Standards, if present

4. Click **Gradebook** to go back to Gradebook; or click **Sign Out**, upper right corner, to quit program
