

**WASHINGTON STATE SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**  
**BELLEVUE SCHOOL DISTRICT**  
**Bellevue, Washington**  
**2008-2009**

**PARENTS:** Washington State School Immunization Law RCW 28A.210.160 requires that all students be properly immunized in order to attend school. Students **may not** be enrolled in school unless a completed Certificate of Immunization Status is submitted. The immunization requirements for school attendance are:

**Daycare/Preschool (Age 19 months and older)**

- 4 doses of DTP Vaccine.
- 3 doses of Polio Vaccine.
- 4 doses or 1 Haemophilus Influenza Type B (Hib) is required **IF** the only dose has been given on or after 15 months of age.
- 1 dose of Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) Vaccine on or after the first birthday.
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B Vaccine.
- 1 dose of Varicella. Parental documentation of the disease is **NO LONGER** acceptable.

**Kindergarten**

- 4 doses of DTP Vaccine with the last dose after age four
- 4 doses of Polio Vaccine **IF** given before 4<sup>th</sup> birthday; or 3 doses **IF** last dose is given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- 2 doses of Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) Vaccine on or after the first birthday and 28 days a part.
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B Vaccine
- 2 doses Varicella vaccination-parental documentation of disease is **NO LONGER** acceptable.

**Grades One through Grade Five:**

- 3 doses of DTP or TD Vaccine with the last dose after age four.
- 4 doses of Polio Vaccine; or 3 doses **IF** last dose is given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- 2 doses of Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) Vaccine on or after the first birthday and 28 days a part.
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B Vaccine
- Varicella vaccination or parent statement with date of chicken pox for **1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade only.**

**Grade Six and Seven:**

- 3 doses DTP/DT/Td Vaccine with the last dose after age four.
- 1 dose Tdap if it has been five years since receiving a tetanus-containing vaccine as listed above
- 3 doses Polio (OPV or IPV) Vaccine with the last dose after age four.
- 2 doses of Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) given on or after age 1 and at least 28 days apart.
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine
- 1 dose of Varicella Vaccine or parent statement that the student has had chickenpox-**6<sup>th</sup> grade only.**

**Grades Eight through Eleven:**

- 3 doses of DTP or DT Vaccine with the last dose after age four
- 3 doses of Polio Vaccine with the last dose after age four
- 2 doses of Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) Vaccine on or after the first birthday at least 30 days apart
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.

**Grade Twelve:**

- 3 doses of DTP/DT/Td Vaccine with the last dose after age four.
- 3 doses of Polio (OPV or IPV) with the last dose after age four.
- 2 doses of Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) Vaccine on or after first birthday and 30 days apart.
- Hepatitis B recommended but not required.

**Exemptions and Substitutions**

1. Laboratory evidence of immunity to measles, mumps, rubella may be substituted for the MMR vaccine.
2. A medical exemption must be certified by a physician's signature on the immunization form.
3. A ***PERSONAL*** or ***RELIGIOUS*** exemption to the immunization requirements may be requested by parent signature on the immunization form.

**In the event of an outbreak of a vaccine preventable disease for which your child is exempt, your child may be excluded from school attendance for the duration of the outbreak.**
