■ Graduation Year

Academic year end.

■ Class Size

Number of high school graduates reported for that academic year.

■ College Direct

Percentage of high school graduates who attended either a two-year or four-year college any time in the academic year immediately following their high school graduation. You can view a graphical representation of this above by selecting the "2-year & 4-year Colleges" option in the "College Type" drop-down filter.

To Two-Year College

Percentage of high school graduates who attended a two-year college any time in the academic year immediately following their high school graduation. You can view a graphical representation of this above by selecting the "2-year Colleges Only" option in the "College Type" drop-down filter.

To Four-Year College

Percentage of high school graduates who attended a four-year college any time in the academic year immediately following their high school graduation. You can view a graphical representation of this above by selecting the "4-year Colleges Only" option in the "College Type" drop-down filter.

Persistence Rate

A calculation of the number of graduates enrolled in a college in the second academic year following their high school graduation year divided by their College Direct number.

Graduated From College

Percentage of the graduating class who has reported graduation from either a two-year or four-year college.

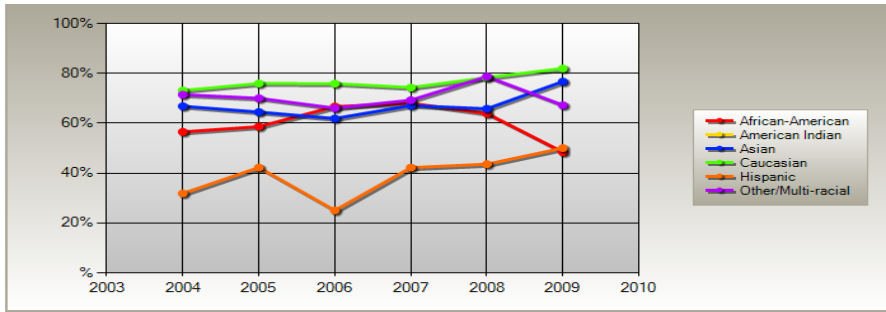
From Two-Year College
