

BOUNDARY CLARIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please review the usage suggestions that follow. You may want to print this page to use as you go through the process.

According to the address you enter in School Boundary Information it will give you the eligible boundaries and routing information that are pertinent. These boundaries are dictated by the program that your child is enrolled into at the school. i.e. Regular, Gifted/Prism, English Second Language, Special Needs or Spanish Immersion.

When first entering the page you will be required to (1) enter your resident address (or appropriate address you are inquiring about) in the box next to Street Address. i.e. 12025 NE 5th ST. After entering the address, (2) select the grade you are interested in or you may check the box for All Grades and All Programs. This will give you an entire listing (there is different criteria that must be met to attend a particular school). If your child is in a special program in the Bellevue School District you will need to select that program number as follows:

None = regular program and Special Needs school will show a 4 in the first digit of the school code. i.e. 432 is Special Needs at Highland Middle School, etc.

2 = Gifted or Prism

3 = English Second Language

5 = Spanish Immersion

Then select **Process**. If you enter an incorrect address or one that has not been added to the database (i.e. a brand new home, etc.) it will return the message "address problem. Please verify that the street number is correct". If you are certain the address is accurate and you are not getting the information you need, please call Transportation at 425-456-4512. If you enter an incomplete address, i.e. ne 5 then it will offer you suggestions like NE 5TH ST OR NE 50TH ST, etc.

You will now be sent into the screen which will give you the boundaries that apply to your particular address and the **Districts School Code number, School & Program Description, Distance to the school (this is by walking path; please note this distance may reflect longer than actual distance because the system does not take into account trails or short cuts) then whether or not you are eligible for a bus stop, and the grades that apply for that school**. As soon as you select the school code that applies from the left column it will generate all the applicable stops for that address and school. It will show the Stop Time, Stop Description, Bus Number (not applicable), Route number and the schools bell time. If there are no stops available it will indicate No Stops Available. To the right top of the bus stop information you may click on MAP and it will show you a map of the Bellevue School District, the stop location, the address location that you entered, and the school location. The tools on the right side of the map will allow you to zoom in or out, show the attendance boundary of your school, etc.

SCHOOL & PROGRAM CODES:

The school program are represented as follows:

0 = Regular Program 2 = Gifted/Prism Program 3 = English Second Language 4 = Special Needs 5 = Spanish Immersion

Please remember there is certain criteria to enroll into a particular program. All programs have different boundaries with different eligibilities.

The last two numbers are the school numbers as follows:
